RESOLUTION 5364**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IDAHO, PARTICIPATING IN AN
ASSESSMENT OF THE COMMUNITY’S 2023 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS PROVIDING
SPECIFIC DATA AS IT PERTAINS TO THE CITY
OF BELLEVUE WITH A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$2,000**

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue, Idaho (“City”), desires to participate in an Assessment of the Community’s 2023 Greenhouse Gas Emissions; and,

WHEREAS, the Assessment would cover the entire area of Blaine County, and the City will receive specific data as it pertains to the City; and,

WHEREAS, Blaine County, local entities, local nonprofit organizations, institutions, businesses, and residents desire to participate in the 5B CAN Blaine County Sustainability and Climate Program (“Program”); and,

WHEREAS, the Program focuses on creating a community where the health of residents and visitors and the health of the environment are viewed as inextricably linked priorities. Where an innovation and resilient economy promotes green jobs stemming from sustainability and climate solutions. Where diversity, equity and inclusion are valued to ensure all residents benefit from opportunities and participation in the community.

WHEREAS, the 2023 assessment will correlate more with energy consumption and emissions from energy production as compared to the 2018 Assessment; and,


WHEREAS, the City’s cost to participate in the assessment will not exceed an amount of \$2,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Bellevue, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Bellevue, Idaho, endorses the participation in an Assessment of the Community’s 2023 Greenhouse Gas Emissions.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign documents and approve associated cost pertaining to the Assessment in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.
