RESOLUTION NO. 2393

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IDAHO,  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT  
WITH FREDRICK ALLINGTON FOR PROSECUTION SERVICES

Idaho Code §50-208 requires that the city attorney, his/her deputies or contract counsel of any municipality shall prosecute those violations of county or city ordinances, state traffic infractions and state misdemeanors committed within the municipal limits; and

The City of Bellevue, Idaho, ("City") desires to enter a contract for legal services for the prosecution of state traffic infractions and state misdemeanors ("Services"); and

The City believes it is in the best interest of the city and its residents to enter into a contract for said Services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:


The City of Bellevue, Idaho, shall enter into a contract with Frederick Allington for the Prosecution of state traffic infractions and state misdemeanors for a term of one (1) year beginning October 1, 2024, and ending September 30, 2025. Compensation shall be \$22,248.00 per year payable in twelve (12) monthly installments of \$1,854.00 per month due on the first day of each month.

The Mayor is authorized to execute the annual contract for Prosecution of City Misdemeanors on behalf of the city in an amount not to exceed \$22,248.00 on behalf of said City.

PASSED by the Bellevue Common Council and signed by the Mayor this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 2024.
