Call to Order:

President Brown called the Regular Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A roll call attendance was conducted, and Council members present were Robin Leahy, Shaun Mahoney, John Carreiro, Doug Brown, Christina Giordani, and Chris Johnson. For the record, Council President Brown, Alderman Johnson, Alderman Carreiro, Alderwoman Leahy, Alderman Mahoney, Alderwoman Giordani, and were physically present in the official meeting location of the Council Chambers of City Hall. A quorum was present for the entire meeting. Staff present were Casey McGehee, PW Operator II, Greg Beaver Fire Chief, Bryson Ellsworth, Water & Wastewater Operator, Shelley Shoemaker, City Treasurer, and Rick Allington, City Attorney.

Notice and Hearing Compliance:

The posting of this regular meeting agenda complied with Idaho Code §74-204. The regular meeting agenda was posted five (5) days prior to the meeting at the Bellevue Post Office, the bulletin board outside of City Hall and on the City website on August 23, 2023. Giordani motioned that the notice agenda was in compliance with Idaho Code §74-204. Johnson seconded. All in favor. The motion passed 6-0.

Brown called for conflict from any Council member or staff member with any agenda items. No conflicts were noted.

2. NEW BUSINESS:

a. **Council Discussion and Decision on the Appointment of a Replacement for Mayor Goldman with Term Expiring January 2024:** Doug Brown, Council President.

Mahoney motioned to nominate Chris Johnson as Mayor. Brown seconded. Roll call vote results: Carreiro–yes, Giordani–yes, Johnson–yes, Mahoney–yes, Leahy–yes, Brown–yes. Motion passed 6-0.

b. **Swearing in Ceremony for Appointed Mayor.** Maria Palomera, Interim City Clerk swore in Chris Johnson as the new Mayor.

3. **EXECUTIVE SESSION:**

a. **EXECUTIVE SESSION ON A PERSONNEL MATTER, PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE §74-206(1)(A)** for the purpose of considering hiring a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent, wherein the respective qualities of individuals are to be evaluated in order to fill a particular vacancy or need: Chris Johnson, Mayor.

b. **ACQUIRING AN INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY NOT OWNED BY CITY, PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE §74-206(1)(C):** Chris Johnson, Mayor and Troy Butzlaff, Athenia Partners.

Motion passed 5-0 and the Council entered Executive Session at 5:39 p.m. Brown motioned to leave Executive Session. Giordani seconded. All in favor. The motion passed and the Council returned to the regular meeting at 6:45 p.m.

6. **OLD BUSINESS:**

a. **Consideration and Approval of Strahorn Slaughterhouse Parking Area Plant Material Replacement (Continued from August 14, 2023 Council Meeting):** Chris Johnson, Mayor. Johnson stated he discussed this matter with Mr. Pfaeffle and the City needs to look at using native plant material, so this item is on hold for now. Jeff Pfaeffle stated he supports the Mayor's direction for plant material.

Johnson stated the notice was advertised on August 9 and August 23, 2023 in the Idaho Mountain Express and posted at City Hall and on social media on August 23, 2023. Brown motioned that the notice agenda was in compliance with Idaho Code §74-204 Carreiro seconded. All in favor. The motion passed 5-0. Errin Bliss with Bliss Architecture outlined the issues experienced in the preliminary plat process. Tony TekaroniAKE Evans with Idaho Mountain Express questioned whether the 100-year easement issue was resolved.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

WITH BDE WATER PROFESSIONALS FOR WATER SYSTEM OPERATIONS

This Second Amendment to the Agreement with BDE Water Professionals ("Second Amendment" or "Amended Agreement") is made and entered into this 11th day of September 2023 by and between the CITY OF BELLEVUE ("City") and BDE Water Professionals ("Operator") and amends that certain "Agreement with BDE Water Professionals for Water System Operations" (the "Agreement") dated January 9, 2023, between the same parties.

RECITALS

- A. On or about January 9, 2023, City and Operator entered into an Agreement pursuant to which the Operator agreed to provide operational support services for the City's water treatment and distribution system ("System").
- B. The Agreement had an initial term of 90-days expiring on April 9, 2023.
- C. The Agreement was Amended ("First Amendment") on or about March 27, 2023 extending the Term until September 23, 2023.
- D. City and Operator desire to amend the Agreement again extending the term for an additional - year and make certain other changes to the Agreement.

AGREEMENT

The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

1. "4. TERM: The Term of this Agreement will be a period of one-year, commencing September 24, 2023, and expiring on September 25, 2024."

2. Exhibit A: Compensation is amended to read:

CITY shall pay OPERATOR for the services during the term of this Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$18,760 per month in accordance with the Compensation Schedule below and made a part of this Agreement.

A monthly retainer fee of \$3,000, which includes use of OPERATOR's licenses and premiums for emergency response and on-call personnel.

Assignment of two (2) Level I Operators for up to 15 hours per week (2x15 hours per week x \$60/hour = \$7,200/month)

2 hours of Responsible Operator in Charge Services at \$90/hour = \$180/month

20 hours of Emergency Response/After Hours Time (\$120/hour x 20 hour = \$2,400/month)

1 hour Responsible Operator in Charge Emergency Response/After Hours Time (\$180 x 1 hour = \$180/month)

Monthly Retainer for Backup Operator=\$600/month

Fully Licensed Operator (\$65/hour x 20/hours per week = \$5,200/month

3. Exhibit B: Scope of Work Operations is amended to include:
 - h) Operator will staff the City's Water System with sufficient numbers of Certified Operators experienced in the City's Water System operation and maintenance to meet regulatory requirements. Operator has the right to use subcontractors and consultants to satisfy its obligations under this Agreement.
4. Except as expressly provided herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.



Library Staff Report

September 2023

Mayor and Council:

Here is what has been happening at the library. As you all know, August was a big month for us!

- In person programming for kids took place each M-Th June 21- Aug. 24. Programs included working with various partnerships to bring “FREE” science-based classes and activities to young patrons aged 5-15. We had a great turnout each week! We will still provide weekly D & D gaming group throughout September, and hopefully beyond.
- I was able to secure a grant from the Idaho AEYC (Association for the Education of Young Children) and The Children’s Reading Foundation for over 300 brand new FREE books to give away to kids! This grant helps to promote literacy among young children ages 0-8 and helps underserved start an “in home library.”
- Partnering with The Hunger Coalition for the school year to bring “Daily Bites” into the library. Daily Bites helps provide nutritious snacks to children in need during the afterschool (but before dinner, if they even get a dinner) hours.
- Helped give away books and promote partnerships at the Peruvian “Mother Earth” celebration held August 12, at the Sawtooth Botanical Garden.
- Promoted and garnered library support and services through print, radio, TV and social media campaigns. Through working these outlets, I have had several meetings with potential donors and granting authorities for FY 2024-2025.
- Working tirelessly on a \$10,000 grant application (through the Idaho Commission for Libraries) which would bring Kindergarten Readiness to local preschool and daycare providers, as well as to parents of underserved, in the form of 6 literacy workshops at the BPL.
- Partnering with the Neighbors Helping Neighbors non-profit to bring Hispanic Heritage Night to Bellevue on September 28, 5:30-7:30 pm – rain or shine!
