The Common Council of the City of Bellevue, Idaho met at a Regular Meeting on Monday, February 10, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City of Bellevue Offices, located at 115 E. Pine Street, Bellevue, ID 83313.

Call to Order: Council President Shay called the Regular Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

1. Notice of Agenda Compliance:

The posting of this regular meeting agenda complied with Idaho Code §74-204. The regular meeting agenda was posted within forty-eight (48) hours prior to the meeting at the Bellevue City Hall, Post Office, and on the City website on *February 20, 2025*.

Motion: Council President Shay moved that the agenda notice was in compliance with Idaho Code §74-204. Council Member Obenauf seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

2. Call for Conflict as Outlined in Idaho Code §74-404:

No conflict was noted.

3. MAYOR AND COUNCIL REPORT

Mayor Giordani thanked the Public Works Department for their efforts with snow removal. Council Member Obenauf said she was going to collaborate with Ashton from the ERC for the annual Clean Sweep event and spoke about reaching out to the County to get fees waived. Council Member Wrede spoke about the progression of the transition to the City's new website from CivicPlus.

4. Public Comment: (for Items of Concern Not on the Agenda)

The Mayor opened the meeting for public comment at 5:34 pm.
No comments were made at this time.

5. CONSENT AGENDA: ALL ACTION ITEMS

Council President Shay pointed out that page one item four in the minutes stated the Mayor opened the meeting, but the Mayor was not present at the meeting. The change was noted by the Clerk. Council Member Bergin Inquired about how the Snowplow Contract amendment would affect the budget. Discussion was had about how extra money could be reallocated if needed.

Motion: Council President Shay moved to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Council Member Obenauf Seconded the Motion. Council Members Voting Aye: Council Member Obenauf, Council Member Bergin, Council Member Wrede, Council Member Shay, Council Member Mahoney. Council Members Voting Nay: None. Council Member Davis was absent for the vote. The Motion Passed..

6. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Request for Authorization for the Mayor to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in coordination with the City of Bellevue and the Blaine County Sherriff's Department for cooperative public safety services in their respective jurisdictions during the 2025 World Cup Finals: Kirtus Gaston, Bellevue Marshall |
ACTION ITEM

Marshal Gaston explained the purpose of the MOU is to help the Sherriff's office with anything they need during the World Cup Finals when resources in the Valley Will be spread thin. Council Member Wrede asked the Marshal about the license plate readers for Bellevue. Marshal Gaston said that is something the City will need in the future, but it may cost a bit of money.

Motion: Council Member Obenauf moved to authorize the Mayor to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in coordination with the City of Bellevue and the Blaine County Sherriff's Department for cooperative public safety services in their respective jurisdictions during the 2025 World Cup Finals. Council Member Mahoney Seconded the Motion. Council Members Voting Aye: Council Member Obenauf, Council Member Bergin, Council Member Wrede, Council Member Shay, Council Member Mahoney. Council Members Voting Nay: None. Council Member Davis was absent for the vote. The Motion Passed

- b. Approval of Resolution No. 25-09 confirming appointment of Diane Shay to the Bellevue Urban Renewal Agency (BURA) Board of Commissioners with a term expiring February 2027 and confirming the reappointment of John Carriero to the BURA Board of Commissioners with a term expiring February 2029 |
ACTION ITEM

Motion: Council Member Bergin moved to Approve of Resolution No. 25-09 confirming appointment of Diane Shay to the Bellevue Urban Renewal Agency (BURA) Board of Commissioners with a term expiring February 2027 and confirming the reappointment of John Carriero to the BURA Board of Commissioners with a term expiring February 2029. Council Member Obenauf Seconded the Motion. Council Members Voting Aye: Council Member Obenauf, Council Member Bergin, Council Member Wrede, Council Member Shay, Council Member Mahoney. Council Members Voting Nay: None. Council Member Davis was absent for the vote. The Motion Passed

7. WORK SESSION

- a. Discussion regarding a new fee structure moving forward for water hydrant connections, future bulk water hookups and dump-station opportunities: Chris Johnson, Public Works Director | **ACTION ITEM**

Public Works Director Chris Johnson went over options for a bulk water fill station and the costs associated with them, as well as potential grant opportunities. He mentioned the approval of an RV dump site at the Maverick Gas Station that he didn't know about until recently. He stated his concern with chemicals that would be used and potential problems it could cause with biology at the wastewater treatment plant and the current lagoon situation. He went on to compare pricing for fill station permits with surrounding jurisdictions.

Mayor Giordani asked about the potential of implementing a mobile meter unit. Mr. Johnson said this option would be the quickest, most economical possibility to use as a starting point and the lift station area would be the best place for it. He went on to discuss the enforcement of the City Ordinance associated with water theft and proposed increases for annual water permit fees. Further discussion was had about penalties for theft of water from hydrants and concern about water contamination from possible backflow.

The Council discussed the current methods of providing water, including short-term use from hydrants and long-term fill stations. They also discussed the potential benefits and drawbacks of these methods, including the cost of providing water and the impact on the City's water system. They agreed that the current system of charging a flat fee for a 30-day permit may not be the most effective way to monetize water usage. The Council considered a metered rate system, which would require infrastructure upgrades. The Council circled back to discuss revising the water use permit system to better regulate and charge for water usage and implementing a base fee plus a yearly permit fee, using the current commercial water rate to calculate this. They also discussed an administrative fee for tracking usage suggesting a yearly permit regardless of usage volume.

Council President Shay asked to revisit the topic of the RV dump site at the Maverik that was brought up at the beginning of this workshop. Brian Parker, Community Development Director explained that the approved Design Review application identified the RV dump site and there is no additional approval associated with it. They still need to get a water and sewer permit, which he stated he will work out with Chris Johnson and Rick Allington. Council President Shay and Council Member Wrede expressed their disapproval with the idea of Bellevue becoming an RV dumping ground. Mayor Giordani said there are RV dump station in every City. Chris Johnson, Public Works Director explained that Bellevue's existing RV park is no different and expressed concern with having two operational dump sites before the wastewater facility is back online. Council Member Bergin said he thought that if the RV Dump Station was not correctly reviewed during the initial design review maybe it could be put on hold until it was thoroughly reviewed. Mayor Giordani looped back to the original workshop topic of pursuing a fill station in Bellevue. The Council agreed it was something they would like to see further pursued.

- b. Discussion and review of the City of Bellevue Comprehensive Plan

Brian Parker, Community Development Director discussed the review of the City's comprehensive plan, assigning a homework task to the Council Members to review and provide feedback in a month from this meeting. Council President Shay reviewed the implementation section of the Comp plan and asked the Council to consider the implementation of the plan and needed updates.

Chris Johnson, Public Works Director addressed the issue of disrespect and threats faced by the City's Street Department, emphasizing the need for a more supportive and respectful community especially revolving around the snow removal efforts.

8. Adjournment:

With no further business coming before the Common Council at this time, Council Member Obenauf moved to adjourn the meeting. Council President Shay seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.



Public Works update March 4, 2025:

Streets – The streets team continues to remove snow from piles around the city to the main snow storage yard. I encourage all council members to take a walk or drive from 2nd street east to 7th street and from Wanut North to Spruce and see for yourself the conditions of the roads. The warm days and the runoff and the freezing temperatures at night are causing frost heaves breaking apart the surface then the runoff again the next day is washing the gravel and creating massive potholes or clusters of potholes. Unfortunately, there isn't much the department can do until it dries out and we can start filling and repairing them to what extent we can.

Water – Still working on the consolidated meter list and filling in missing information like meter size and type of use (single family, business, mixed use). We had a productive meeting with our water project team, just finishing up a few clarifying questions and holding another meeting with our engineers and our legal team to develop a MOU so Ee Da Ho and our project team are on the same understanding of intent, scope of work and location. We are expecting to start survey work once the snow clears and finish out the environmental document. Then we can move into preliminary engineering and should have the engineering complete and ready for public comment and DEQ review this fall. With the transition to Cassell we can start moving forward to bringing our meters online. We need to ensure the accuracy of the meter list and the accounts in Cassell are correct and we can import that list into the Neptun Meter reading software. I anticipate we could start seeing live reads in June and transition to a metered rate by September/October.

Wastewater – Electricians are making good progress and have removed the old wires and panels. They have set the new panels and have much of the conduit hung and in place. We have had some setbacks with getting the proper couplers for two of the pumps, but they arrived on March 3rd and should be installed on Friday March 7th. We also found that most of the sensors have corroded and cannot be repaired. We have identified them and have sent lists to suppliers for quotes and hope to order them as soon as possible.

Parks, Building and Grounds – We are seeing new graffiti around town primarily on signs. We continue to remove it and keep up with any maintenance that can be done at this time.


Item: Hydrant Meter w/ Backflow Preventor

Background: Council requested that research be conducted on ways to meter and better control our bulk water permitting. A full station would require engineering and DEQ approval, which from previous projects in other jurisdictions could cost between \$100,000 and \$200,000.

Recommendation: A hydrant meter with a backflow prevention device with a single point of use with a second one on hand for site specific use would meet the ability to track the water use and ensure there is a backflow device present.

Item: Snow Plus Tires for Leased Loader

Background: Loader was acquired on a lease and ordered by the City Administrator. The upgrade to snow plus tires was not considered. Even with all wheel drive the loader loses traction when the roads become covered in snow and ice. This presents a hazard to the operator and reduces the work the loader can do. Upon completion of the lease the loader must be returned with at least 50% tread life on the tires.

Recommendation: To get full use out of the loader, Snow Plus tires should be installed. Purcell Tire and Rubber Co. provided a quote for \$14,569.26. The other quote was nearly \$6000 more. The current tires can be covered and stored until completion of the lease and then reinstalled to meet the 50% tread life requirement.

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-02**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BELLEVUE CITY CODE TITLE 3 CHAPTER 2 SECTIONS 3 AND 8 ADDING THE REQUIREMENT OF AN ALCOHOL AWARENESS CLASS FOR THE APPLICANT/BUSINESS OWNER PRIOR TO ANY ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR LICENSES AND ADDING LANGUAGE PROHIBITING RESORT CITY RESTAURANTS FROM PROMOTING OR OPERATING AS A BAR AND LOUNGE.

WHEREAS, The City of Bellevue is authorized by the state of Idaho to make all such ordinances, bylaws, rules, regulations and resolutions not inconsistent with the laws of the state of Idaho as may be expedient; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §23-916 authorizes the City to provide further regulations relating to the issuance of licenses for the sale of liquor by the drink; and

WHEREAS, The City finds that requiring an alcohol awareness training as a condition to receiving a liquor license promotes the general health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Bellevue

The City of Bellevue does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That Bellevue City Ordinance 3-2-3 be amended by adding the underlined:

3-2-3: APPLICATION FOR LICENSE:

C. The applicant/business owner for a license shall be required to attend an alcohol awareness training approved by the Bellevue Marshall prior to the issuance or renewal of any City issued liquor, beer, and/or wine license. The training shall be attended in-person with the Bellevue Marshal’s Office, or online with the Idaho State Police. Proof of attendance is required and shall be kept on file by the City Clerk.

SECTION 2. That Bellevue City Ordinance 3-2-1 be amended by adding the underlined:

3-2-8: HOURS AND AREAS OF SALES:

C. No business holding a resort city restaurant liquor license shall promote or operate the restaurant as a bar and lounge.



Re: Lucy's Breakfast Resort Liquor License Application

On 02-01-2025 Bellevue Marshal's Office received a complaint that Lucy's Breakfast was serving liquor at their establishment and was promoting sales on their social media. Upon investigation we found unsecured liquor at the establishment that was not fully licensed for such sales or services. At the time of this investigation Lucy's Breakfast had only obtained the State of Idaho license for liquor. On the State of Idaho Liquor License Application instructions page at the bottom in bold states "City and County license are required before you can serve alcohol."

In the social media promotions made by Lucy's Breakfast it shows what appears to be shots and mixed drinks being handled to include using what appears to be a liquor bottle "toasting" within the unlicensed establishment.

On 02-12-2025 the City of Bellevue received an application for Annual Retail Alcoholic Beverage amending Lucy's Breakfast to allow liquor by the drink. At this time Lucy's Breakfast is only open until 1500 hours per her business license and online recourses. The City of Bellevue passed an ordinance for Resort City Liquor license allowing up to 3 licenses be issued with hours of service for such sales be between 1600 and 2200 hours. On 02/24/2025 the applicant amended her application giving a dinner menu with future operation hours of 1600 to 2200 hours "when/if we get the license."

Idaho Code 23-903c (2) states "no less than sixty percent (60%) of gross sales from the preceding twelve (12) month operation of a licensed restaurant be derived from food services." 23-903c(3)b states "no resort city restaurant licensed pursuant to this section shall promote or operate the restaurant as a bar and lounge."

It is the recommendation of the Bellevue Marshal's Office to deny the application.

- 1.) Due to possible violation of BCC 3-2-2,
- 2.) Being warned on the State License application not to serve prior to obtaining City and County licenses and clearly having served as part of a promotional video.
- 3.) Not currently open the hours of allowable service for liquor per BCC.


If the establishment opened for food sales during the allowable service times and amended their business license to reflect those hours they could potentially come into compliance with this provision.



Idaho Statutes

Idaho Statutes are updated to the website July 1 following the legislative session.

TITLE 23
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
CHAPTER 9

RETAIL SALE OF LIQUOR BY THE DRINK

23-903c. LICENSES ISSUED TO RESORT CITY RESTAURANTS. (1) Resort city restaurant liquor license. Upon a finding of proof by the mayor and city council and subject to approval of the mayor and city council and notwithstanding the population limitations set forth in section 23-903(1), Idaho Code, nothing in this chapter shall prohibit the issuance of a resort city restaurant liquor license to the owner, operator, or lessee for use at a qualifying restaurant within the incorporated limits of a city that qualified as a resort city as of July 1, 2024, subject to the provisions of this section. For purposes of this section, "resort city" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 50-1044, Idaho Code, and means a city that is farther than fifteen (15) miles by road from any city with a population of fifty thousand (50,000) or more as established in the last preceding census and has sewage flows that exceed low-season flows by twenty percent (20%) or more. "Restaurant" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 23-942, Idaho Code.

(2) Qualifying restaurant. To be eligible for issuance of a resort city restaurant liquor license, a restaurant shall demonstrate that the primary source of revenue from the operation of the restaurant to be licensed will be derived from food services and not from the sale of liquor. Subsequent license renewals shall be conditioned upon a showing that no less than sixty percent (60%) of gross sales from the preceding twelve (12) month operation of a licensed restaurant be derived from food services.

(3)(a) Restaurant operations. A restaurant selling liquor pursuant to a resort city restaurant liquor license shall abide by the following:

(i) Liquor shall be dispensed and prepared for consumption by a restaurant licensed pursuant to this section only in areas approved by the local licensing authority; and

(ii) All liquor sales shall cease at the time food sales and services cease. The local licensing authority may impose additional date and time restrictions on liquor sales.

(b) No resort city restaurant licensed pursuant to this section shall promote or operate the restaurant as a bar and lounge.

(4)(a) Licenses per city. No more than three (3) resort city restaurant liquor licenses may be issued for use within the incorporated limits of a single resort city. In the event the mayor and city council do not approve the proposed license, a license shall not be issued. Priority shall be given on a first-come, first-served basis according to date of application and the following:

(i) First to those who applied for a license within the incorporated city prior to July 1, 2024, contingent on the

ability for actual use as a resort city restaurant liquor license; and

(ii) Second to those who apply for a resort city restaurant liquor license on or after July 1, 2024.

(b) Resort city liquor licenses shall not count toward the limitation on the number of licenses issued according to population, as provided in section 23-903(1), Idaho Code.

(5) Sale, lease, and transfer prohibited. A resort city restaurant liquor license may not be sold or leased and shall not be transferable to any other location, facility, or premises.

(6) The fees for licenses granted pursuant to this section shall be the same as those set forth in section 23-904(1), (2), and (3), Idaho Code.

HOURS OF SALE FOR RESORT CITY RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE**

The City of Bellevue does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That Bellevue City Ordinance 3-2-1 be amended by adding the following definition:

3-2-1: DEFINITIONS:

RESORT CITY RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE: A limited quantity liquor license obtained pursuant to Idaho Code §23-903(c) and generally available on a first-come first-served basis to restaurants that can demonstrate that the primary source of revenue from the operation of the restaurant to be licensed will be derived from food services and not from the sale of liquor.

SECTION 2. That Bellevue City Ordinance 3-2-8 be amended by adding the underlined and deleting the strikethrough language.

3-2-8: HOURS AND AREAS OF SALES:

A. ~~Except as provide herein, N~~no person shall sell or purchase alcoholic liquor by the drink within the City limits on any day between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and ten o'clock (10:00) A.M. Resort City Restaurant Liquor License holders shall not sell alcoholic liquor by the drink, offer liquor for sale, or give away liquor upon the licensed premises within the City limits on any day between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00) P.M. and four o'clock (4:00) P.M.


B. ~~After food sales and services cease, any patron present on the licensed premises holding a Resort City Restaurant Liquor License, shall have thirty (30) minutes or until 10:30 P.M. (whichever is earlier) to consume any alcoholic liquor already served.~~
