Special Meeting Minutes

12:02 p.m. Call to Order:

Mayor Goldman called the Special Meeting to order. A roll call attendance was conducted, and Council members present were Doug Brown, Shaun Mahoney, Greg Cappel (arrived 12:18pm), Chris Johnson, Jennifer Rangel, and Robin Leahy (arrived 12:05pm), all appearing by teleconference. For the record, no one was absent. For the record, Clerk/Treasurer Edwards was physically present in the official meeting location of the Council Chambers of City Hall. A quorum was present for the entire meeting. Staff present were Rick Allington, City Attorney; Greg Beaver, Fire Chief; and Marian Edwards, City Clerk/Treasurer.

Notice and Hearing Compliance:

The posting of this regular meeting agenda complied with Idaho Code 74-204. The Special Meeting notice and agenda were posted in accordance with Idaho Code §74-204 more than 24 hours days prior to the meeting, at the Bellevue Post Office, on the bulletin board of City Hall and on the City website on March 31, 2022. Brown motioned that the notice was in compliance with Idaho Code 74-204. Johnson seconded. All in favor. The motion passed.

1. Executive Session to Discuss Personnel Pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206 (1), subsections (a) & (b): (a) To consider hiring a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent; and, (b) To consider the evaluation, dismissal, or discipling of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent. Brown motioned to enter executive session pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206 (1), subsections (a) & (b): (a) To consider hiring a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent; and, (b) To consider the evaluation, dismissal or discipling of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent. Johnson seconded. Roll call vote results: Mahoney- yes, Brown- yes, Cappel- not present, Johnson- yes, Rangel- yes, Leahy- yes. Motion passed and the Council entered executive session at 12:07pm.

Johnson motioned to leave executive session. Brown seconded. All in favor. The motion passed and the Council returned to the special meeting at 12:58pm

2. Public Works Hiring Discussion. Goldman noted that she recommends that the City hire a Public Works Director as the City has significant infrastructure needs to address. Brown said that he agrees that a professional Public Works leader was needed. Johnson noted that leadership was needed. Rangel noted that the staff needed mentorship. Johnson motioned to move forward toward hiring a Public Works Director with an annual salary range of \$80,000 to


\$110,000, commensurate with experience. Brown seconded. Roll call vote results: Mahoney- not present, Brown- yes, Cappel-yes, Johnson- yes, Rangel- yes, Leahy- yes. Motion passed

3. Adjournment. Brown motioned to adjourn. Johnson seconded. All in favor and the meeting ended at 1:03pm.
