**Subject:** Jackie Peppard Verbal Comment Read from Written Comments re August 10 2026

For whatever reason, the comments attached to this email, I thought were sent on August 10 2026, apparently were not. I reread the curated verbal comments of the minutes of 8.10.2026 contained in the September 14 2026 Agenda Packet, and they are not accurate for most of the comments made verbally in that meeting.

I also witnessed first hand the errors made by the city's transcription computer program in the last meeting held before Labor Day (chaired by Diane Shay in the Mayor's absence), and Diane saw them too. They are wildly inaccurate.

Verbal comments are not accurately reflected in the record. Please get a new program. The Teams meeting minutes and video produced by the corporation I am

employed by are available within 30 minutes. This is a large corporation with many more participants than ever show up at City Council Meetings. The local press has had problems getting City Council transcripts, including audio records.

This is not transparency. Nor can the citizen's voices be heard and accurately reported.

For what it is worth, attached is the commentary I prepared and read from, on August 10th.

I also urge that you allow more time for residents to submit written comment or allow written comment to be submitted in person, the day of the meeting. The day of written comments submitted by noon are never including in the public agenda packet anyway, so why bar them from being submitted at the then current meeting?
